# **Roadmap to Success**<sup>™</sup>

At <u>Cocca House</u>, a group of determined teenagers completed our 6 week "Hustle for Freedom" business bootcamp, walking away with more than just business knowledge. They discovered their mission, defined their values, and learned how these guiding principles can steer them through the challenges of entrepreneurship and life.



These young visionaries who once ran from adversity now see obstacles as opportunities and setbacks as stepping stones. By building confidence and instilling purpose, we're equipping the next generation to navigate the ups and downs of their journeys with resilience and clarity. Their graduation is not just a milestone, it's the beginning of a future of leadership where they lead with intention and inspire change in their community and among their peers.

# **Roadmap to Success**<sup>™</sup>

Summer 2024 we had the incredible opportunity to work with 100+ Albany County Youth Employment Participants, ages 14-19 through an array of programs.

## 5-Day Workforce Development Program:

Comprehensive dive into career skills and job readiness.

## 3-Day Business Bootcamp:

• Focused on entrepreneurial skills and business fundamentals.

## 2-Day Workforce and Business Bootcamp:

• A compact, intensive course covering essential workforce and business skills.

These programs provided invaluable tools for career and entrepreneurial success.



## **Roadmap to Success**<sup>™</sup>

Check out the impactful work through an 8-week course for youth in foster care. We equipped these young individuals with the skills and confidence they need to navigate their personal and professional lives.

#### Personal Development:

Throughout the course, participants, aged 13 to 18, demonstrated significant growth in self-esteem, communication skills, and overall confidence. These are crucial attributes that will serve them well in any future endeavors.

#### Skill Acquisition:

Despite a shift in focus from workforce readiness to personal growth, the youth gained practical skills such as resume building, interview techniques, and problem-solving. These tailored skills prepare them for the challenges they may face as they transition into adulthood.

#### Goal Setting and Achievement:

Participants set personal goals at the start of the program, and I'm proud to report substantial progress. Through the introduction of SMART goals, these young individuals began setting daily objectives—a habit that will foster continued personal growth.

#### Hope and Motivation:

Hope and motivation grew steadily throughout the program, culminating in a powerful realization among participants: they left knowing and believing that all things are possible and that they have greatness within them. The completion of this course represents not just an achievement, but a profound shift in their mindset. I am incredibly proud of the journey we've undertaken together and the lasting impact this program has had on their lives.


The results from our post-program surveys, highlight the incredible knowledge growth and transformation that took place during our time together. The insights we've gathered show just how much progress has been made!

These results demonstrate the powerful impact of our program, Roadmap to Success™.



#### How confident do you feel now about setting personal goals using the SMART criteria?




